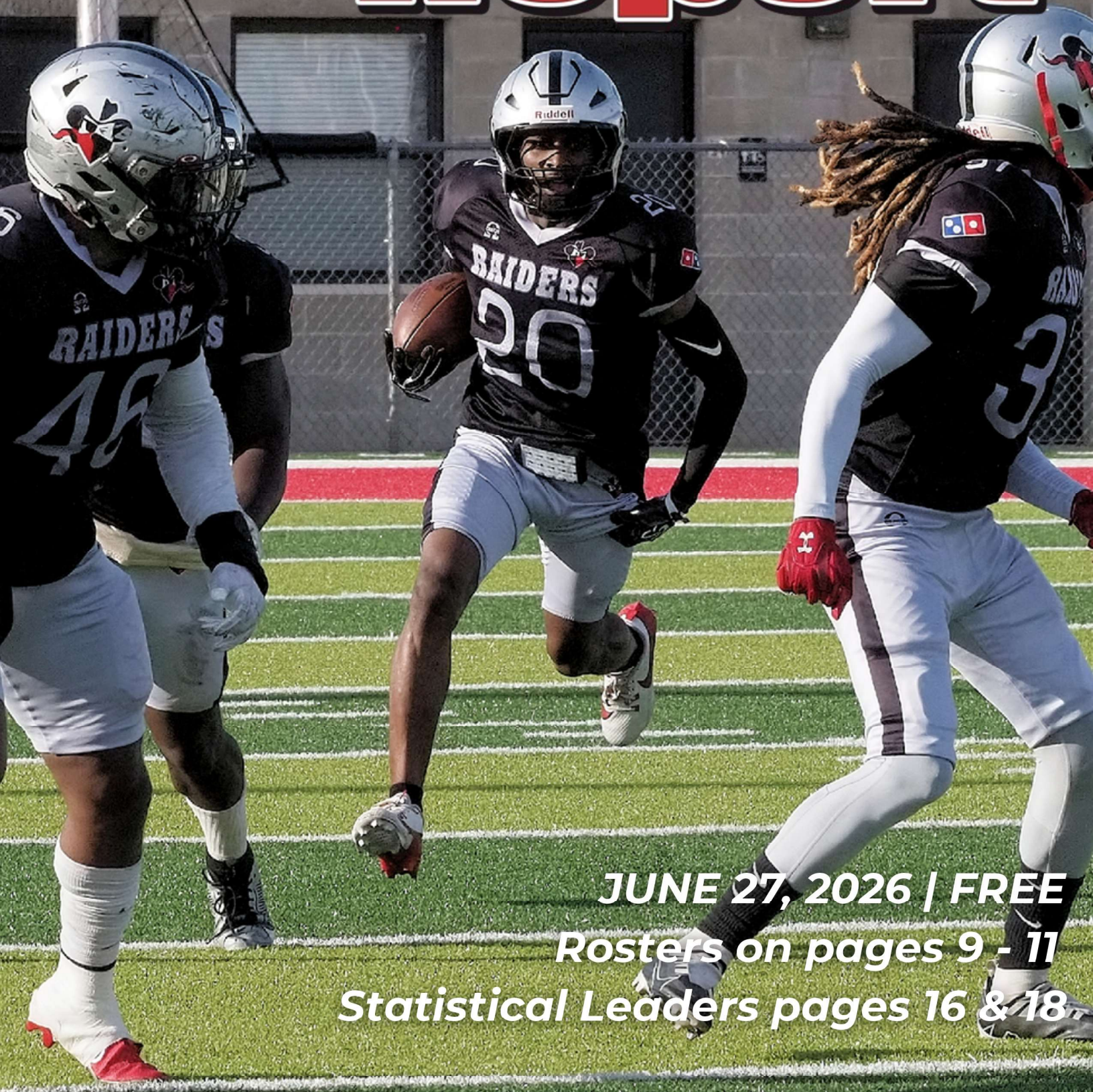

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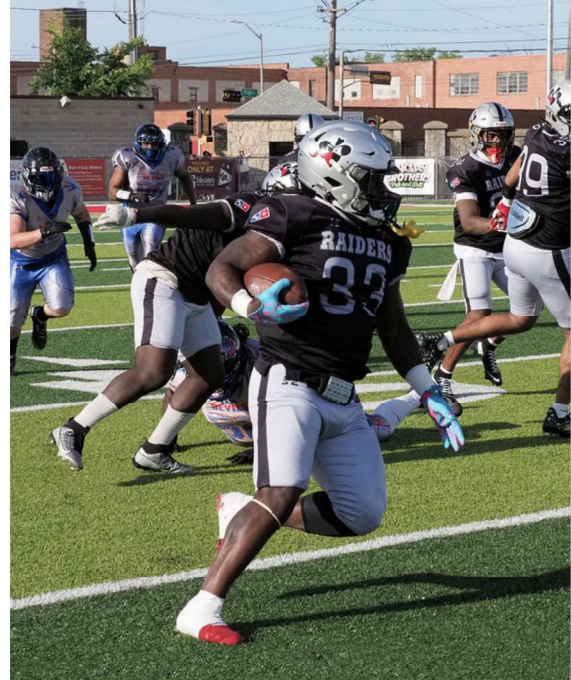

# Racine Raiders rout Burlington 55-0 as injuries end game early

**RACINE, WI** — The Racine Raiders opened the scoring Saturday night against the Burlington Blue Devils on an 8-yard run by running back Ricky Lollis. It didn't take long for the floodgates to open — again.

The Raiders scored in multiple ways, including another punt return touchdown by Tre Carothers and a defensive touchdown by Gianni Scacco, and went home early after the Blue Devils ran out of players because of injuries in a 55-0 Mid-West United Football League victory at Horlick Field. The game ended with 4:52 left in the third quarter.

In two games against Burlington — their first meeting was a 54-0 win in the season opener — the Raiders (7-0, 4-0 MWUF) have outscored the Blue Devils 109-0.

“They were short on players, so conditioning comes into play as a factor,” Raiders coach Wilbert Kennedy said. “I’m sure they were missing some key players, so that hurts. Your talent level will hurt your field output. These (lopsided) games can be detrimental if the guys don’t stay focused, but I thought our guys played hard the entire time. So as long as they’re playing hard and they’re trying to execute the things like they were supposed to, you can still get good work in.”

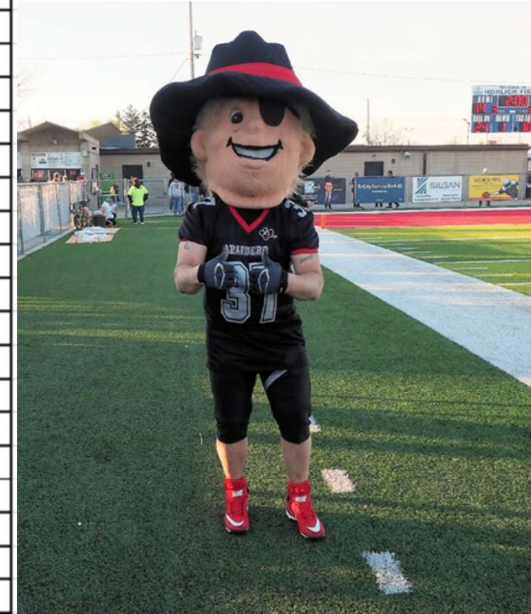

## Special teams strike again

After the Lollis touchdown, which came just a couple of minutes into the game, the Blue Devils (2-4 MWUF) went three-and-out and punted to Carothers, who returned two punts for touchdowns against Burlington in the season opener. Carothers didn't disappoint, taking the punt down the right sideline before angling across the field to the end zone for his third return touchdown of the season, all against Burlington.

"It's pretty fun out there," Carothers said. "(My teammates on special teams) have no trouble blocking for a guy like me, and I have no trouble checking down for them. It was all good for us."

After another Blue Devils three-and-out, Burlington punted again and Carothers almost did it again. Fellow returner Nate McKenzie tried to catch the punt and dropped it, and Carothers picked it up. Despite the broken play, Carothers broke some tackles and was knocked out of bounds on the 4-yard line.

One play later, quarterback Sawyer Schick hit wide receiver DJ McKinstry on a 4-yard out for the third touchdown of the game and a 20-0 lead after the first quarter.

## Second-quarter surge

There were more fireworks in the second quarter, starting with a 9-yard touchdown pass from Schick to Lollis early for a 27-0 lead.



A few minutes later, the Raiders got the ball back and Schick did it himself, scrambling for a 10-yard touchdown run and a 34-0 lead.

With four minutes left in the first half, veteran running back Howard Triplett showed he still has the wheels by running down the left sideline and breaking a late tackle to score on a 65-yard run for a 41-0 Raiders lead.

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## Defense adds points

Then it was Scacco's turn. The 5-foot-9, 170-pound linebacker got his first start of the season and made the most of it. He had an earlier interception on a tipped ball, then wowed the crowd with a second pick, also off a deflection, and ran it back 43 yards into the endzone with 42 seconds left in the first half. Scacco, the son of Raiders assistant coach Vinnie Scacco, was understandably hyped for his first touchdown as a Raider.

"I saw some open field, saw my teammates, went that way and they blocked for me and I got to the end zone," Gianni Scacco said. "I just got the opportunity (to start) and went with it. I love to hit — that's my favorite part of the game."

Kennedy was also impressed with Scacco's effort. "He's not the typical size of a linebacker, but being able to see him in this situation, we picked up things that we could utilize him for," Kennedy said. "When he was on special teams, he was always hitting somebody bigger than him. He's always around the football and it showed in the game."

The second half was somewhat uneventful. Burlington received the kickoff, promptly went three-and-out, then punted 14 yards. On the third play of the ensuing drive, backup running back Geoffrey Mazur ran up the middle, shed a shoulder tackle and scored on a 27-yard run to cap the scoring.

The Blue Devils had a 1-yard punt on their next drive, but the Raiders were unable to score. On a third-down pass from backup quarterback Gavin Gutman to tight end Ian Gaines, a Burlington defender was injured and the game ended shortly thereafter.

With a bye week next Saturday, Kennedy gave his players the week off. When the Raiders return, they will face one of their toughest opponents of the season, the Sheboygan SaberCats (8-1), at Horlick Field.

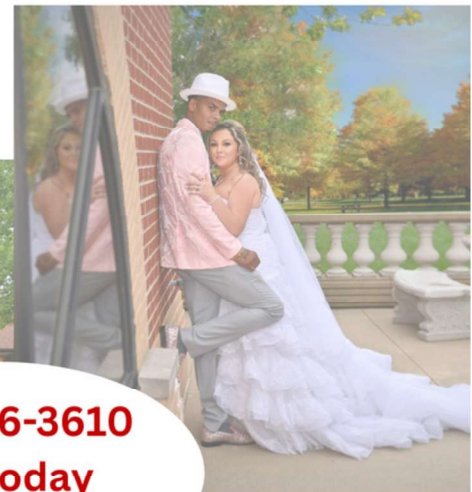
