# Raiders stay undefeated on Quan Jackson's crucial interception

**RACINE, WI** — Quan Jackson was playing with a heavy heart Saturday night, but came up with perhaps the play of the season to keep the Racine Raiders undefeated. The first-year defensive back intercepted an overthrown pass by Sheboygan County SaberCats standout quarterback Justin Billiot on a third down-and-23 play to seal a thrilling 17-16 victory for the Raiders in a Mid-West United Football League game at Horlick Field.

The Raiders had just gone ahead on a 22-yard field goal by Brady Wodack coming out of the two-minute warning, and the win kept the Raiders unbeaten at 7-0 overall and 5-0 in the MWUF.

The Raiders also got another return touchdown from Tre Carothers, his fourth of the season and first on a kickoff.

The SaberCats were a challenge unlike any other the Raiders have faced this season. Sheboygan County was near the top of the MWUF Central Division with the Raiders and had similar blowout victories against their common league foes.

Billiot is one of the best quarterbacks in the league as well, but Jackson's shining moment against Billiot almost didn't happen.

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Raiders defensive coordinator Pete Deates wasn't even sure he was going to be at the game. Two days before, Jackson's girlfriend's grandmother passed away, leaving behind several grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

"He called me and told me," Deates said. "I'm like, 'dude, this is a big game, and I want you there, but nobody is going to hold this against you if you don't come. He showed up right before the game, and I said 'are you playing?' He said, 'I'm here.' He walked up to me and gave me a hug and was crying. It was an emotional game for him. I even gave him a hug afterwards, and I said 'I couldn't be happier for you making this play after everything that you're going through.' "

Jackson, who was mobbed by his teammates after the interception, said she was like a mother to him and dedicated the game to her.

"I wasn't sure if I was going to play," Jackson said. "She was really with me every step of the way. My heart's still heavy. It goes out to the family."

The play was preceded by a big sack by linebacker Gary Young Jr., a 13-yard loss that took the SaberCats (5-2, 5-1) out of Raiders' territory with about a minute left in the game. On the next play, Billiot threw the pick.



"Shout-out to the linebackers and the D-line," Jackson said. "They make my job as a defensive back so much easier when they can put pressure on the quarterback and force him to throw a pass that he's really not comfortable with."

"I just stayed locked in, stayed in my keys and in my zone."

The Raiders fell behind 16-14 with 8:19 left in the game after the SaberCats went on an 80-yard drive that began early in the fourth quarter. The big play on the drive was a 55-yard pass from Billiot to wide receiver Jalonzo Jackson, one play after he dropped a pass.

The SaberCats scored on a 4-yard pass to Kaden Summerville to tie the game, then got a 2-point conversion to take the lead.

Carothers returned the ensuing kickoff to the Raiders' 42-yard line, then running back Ricky Lollis went to work. Lollis, who finished with 80 yards rushing on 15 attempts, carried the ball eight straight times, and the SaberCats helped with an illegal hands to the face penalty and an unsportsmanlike conduct penalty on the same play to bring the ball to the SaberCats 9-yard line.

A holding penalty by the Raiders was a minor setback, then two runs by Lollis got the ball to the 5-yard line, and Wodack split the uprights, into the wind, from 22 yards. In the third quarter, he missed from 39 yards with the wind at his back. Wodack said it was his first game-winning field goal since his high school days at Sturgeon Bay. He didn't kick field goals in college for St. Norbert.

"I was struggling more with the wind at my back today," Wodack said. "I don't really know why I was (having trouble) at the other end of the field.

"(On the game-winner) I didn't really think about the wind. I told myself 'just keep your head down and swing through it. Do your fundamentals, it's going to be good.' So that's all that's going through my head at that point."

And then there was Carothers. He has three punt return touchdowns this season, all against Burlington, but he showed how dangerous he is on kickoffs. He caught the ball over his shoulder at his own 9-yard line, ran left, back to the middle and to the left again for his first kickoff return of the season.

"They were talking about kicking to the younger guy, because you know my older (teammates), they don't want to kick it to them, so I have to prove them wrong when they try to kick it to me," said Carothers, who was a two-time NJCAA Division III All-American at North Dakota State College of Science, as a wide receiver and kick returner.







The Raiders' defense is the best in the MWUF and played like it for the most part. The defense kept the SaberCats' running game in check, allowing just 59 yards on the ground. Billiot was 11 of 21 for 207 yards, but the Raiders also sacked him five times for 55 yards in losses.

Young had two sacks totaling 20 yards and defensive lineman Carter Mayer also had two sacks and Young, defensive back Jordan Danowski and linebacker William Hogland each had seven tackles. Danowski and linebacker Elvin Turner each had five solos.

"Justin (Billiot), he's a hell of a quarterback," Raiders head coach Wilbert Kennedy said. "He's very talented. At any level, when you have a guy that caliber playing in your quarterback position, it gives you great opportunities. We gave up 14 points and that's the most we've given up this year so far, but I thought our defense did play very well. I thought we played the run game pretty dang good."

Young was instrumental in that defense. He had one sack in the first half, then didn't have another one until the fourth quarter.

"Usually they have me blitz off the edge," Young said. "But with the passing game that they were doing, we had to kind of pretty much make an adjustment to counter that. We're the number one defense, so you've got to show and act like it. So once we get on the field, any play we can make, we've got to do."

The Raiders struggled in the first half with penalties, including several false starts and a few holding calls, and Kennedy was not happy with that.

"In the first quarter we had the ball for over eight minutes and drove the length of the field a couple times, but the penalties kept putting us back," Kennedy said. "We had a 50-yard run by Ricky Lollis and there was a hold so that came back, and another big run, and that one came back. And then we didn't get it in the end zone or get a field goal. So you can't have wasted opportunities like that."
